- \* Grievances of similar nature, relating to a particular department shall be put in a single group at Gram Panchayat level. Each such group shall be considered as a single grievance for the purpose of disposal thereof.
  - \*\* Total no. of grievances included in groups means-all applications/grievances of similar nature included in the groups.
- Expl: If 12 grievances relating to PHED are put in 3 groups, then column 8 will show a figure of 3 and column 9 will show a figure of 12 for a Gram Panchayat. Taking example of the whole district, there may be 25 groups of PHED containing 300 applications. It would imply that 300 grievances shall stand reduced to 25 and the reduction in grievances will be 275. However, the grievances that cannot be included in a particular group shall continue to be counted as separate grievances.
